Participants: Over 15 years old, domestic and foreign cyclists who are capable of completing the route. Please apply for personal accident insurance by yourself.

Grouping method: 3/4 grouping is the same as the method of the "Yangmingshan KOM" competition.

3/5 "Taiwan Climbing Series - North Coast of Yangmingshan"

Challenge group: Men and women are divided into 15-60 years old, one age group for every five years.

Electric-assisted vehicle group: limited to electric-assisted bicycles, regardless of gender and age.

Activity fee:

1. Participation in both day events (March 4th Yangmingshan KOM and the March 5th North Coast event, a total of \$1,600NT, plus a chip deposit of 500 yuan.

2. Only registration fee for 3/5 Taiwan Summit Series - North Coast of Yangmingshan is \$800NT per person, plus a chip deposit of 500 yuan.

Fee includes: KOM souvenirs, number identification, completion medals, timing results, electronic certificates of completion, insurance, supplies, etc.

Registration method: Please visit the website www.cyclist.org.tw link, from now until February 18 or when the quota is full.

Reward method: 3/4 event prizes are the same as those of Yangmingshan KOM competition.

3/5 "Taiwan Summit Series - North Coast of Yangmingshan"

Participants will receive exquisite commemorative trophies and exquisite completion certificates.

Men's and women's two-day ranking champions will be awarded the second group of LOOK KEO pedals.

The overall champion of each age group will be ranked on the second day, and a KOM commemorative car jacket will be awarded to each age group.

Participation notice:

Self-provided bicycles: road handlebars, flat handlebar road bikes, and road tire off-road bikes can be used.

Riding equipment: bicycles, gloves, helmets (required), water bottles, sunglasses, etc.
