

# Tour of East Taiwan TTT & Race 2025

Celebrating its 25th anniversary since first held in 2001, *Tour of East Taiwan* is one of the oldest and most significant two-day road cycling event in Taiwan. This year, the race begins with a team time trial on the first day, followed by two days of races along the Hualien-Taitung coastline highway and the East Rift Valley Highway.

As a key event in the Taiwan Cyclist League, *Tour of East Taiwan* is part of a lineup that includes *Tai ping King of the Mountain* in May, *The Road to Taiwan KOM-Summer* in June, *Hualien Pacific Road Race* in November, and *Yunlin Cycling Criterium* in December, acting as the last race. The events this year will continue to be based on individual road races while incorporating team time trials to foster team organization and planning, thereby enhancing the overall level of cycling teams and the sport.

12:30 Finish Line Cutoff at Yanliao (10K Mark on Province Highway 11) \*Participants will move back to Sunrise Boulevard to receive finisher medal, lunch, and return timing chips for deposit refund.

## Route:

### 4/11 (Fri.) Team Time Trial:

Farglory Ocean Park - Yanliao - Tiaolang Tunnel (Turning Point) - Endpoint Approx. 20 km.

### 4/12 (Sat.) Hualien - Taitung (Hualien-Taitung Coastal Highway/Province Highway 11, about 130 km)

Start Line: Hualien Sunrise Boulevard - Hai'an Rd/County Highway 193 - Hualien Bridge/Province Highway 11 (Release after crossing the bridge) - Niushan Tunnel - Jiqi - Tropic of Cancer - Changbin - Chenggong - Duli - East Coast National Scenic Area Headquarters (Endpoint+Award Ceremony)

### 4/13 (Sun.) Taitung - Hualien (Hualung Highway/Province Highway 9, Yuchang Road/Province Highway 30, Hualien-Taitung Coastal Highway/Province Highway 11, approx. 178 km.)

Start Line: Formosan Naruwan Hotel - Guanshan, Chishang, Yuli on Province Highway 9 - Changbing, Fengbing on Province Highway 11 - Yanliao (Endpoint+Award Ceremony)

## Participation Requirement:

### 1. Team Time Trial

Participants must be older than 16 years old and register as a group. The team time trial is limited to participants who have signed up for the road race. Each team should include 5 members, and the team's score is based on the time of the 4th person to reach the finish line. A team jersey for each team is required. There are no gender limitations.

### 2. Two-Day Road Race

Participants must be older than 12 years old and have road race or self-challenge experience. Personal Race Insurance is required.

### Registration Fee:

1. **Team Time Trial:** NT\$1000 per team

2. **Two-Day Road Race:** NT\$2000 per person.

\*An additional deposit of NT\$500 for the timing chip will be charged.

\*For accommodation bookings and additional product purchases, please refer to the website.

### Fee Includes:

Souvenir T-shirt, Souvenir Teddy Bear, Race Bib, Number Stickers, Bike Plate, Lunch, 2 Finisher Medals, Electronic Completion Certificate, Timing Results, Insurance, etc.

### Booking Service:

1. Accommodations in Hualien on 4/11

2. Formosan Naruwan Hotel in Taitung on 4/12, including breakfast and dinner buffet.

3. Tour of East Taiwan T-shirt, Jersey, biking hat, etc.

### Timing Chip Deposit:

Deposit will be refunded as participants return the chips at the endpoint.

### Race Grouping: (Limited to drop-bar road bikes only)

#### 1. Team Time Trial:

The team's score is based on the time of the 4th person to reach the finish line. There are no gender limitations.

#### 2. Two-Day Road Race:

M16 Group: Male aged 16-19, born in 2006-2009

M20 Group: Male aged 20-24, born in 2001-2005

M25 Group: Male aged 25-29, born in 1996-2000

M30 Group: Male aged 30-34, born in 1991-1995

M35 Group: Male aged 35-39, born in 1986-1990

M40 Group: Male aged 40-44, born in 1981-1985

M45 Group: Male aged 45-49, born in 1976-1980

M50 Group: Male aged 50-54, born in 1971-1975

M55 Group: Male aged 55-59, born in 1966-1970

M60 Group: Male aged above 60, born before 1965

W35 Group: Female aged below 35, born in 1990-2009

W36 Group: Female aged above 36, born before 1989

## Registration Method:

Please visit the event registration link on our website ([www.cyclist.org.tw](http://www.cyclist.org.tw)). Registration is open from now until March 10th.

## Rewards:

1. All participants will receive their finisher medal at the endpoint of both days and have access to an electronic completion certificate from our official website.
2. Awards will be presented to the top six of team time trial.
3. Awards will be presented to the top six of males and females of each group for the race each day.
4. Awards will be presented to the top six of the overall rank of *Tour of East Taiwan*.
5. Awards will be presented to the top six females of the overall rank of *Tour of East Taiwan*.

\*Overall ranking is the sum of the team time trial results and the total results from both days.

6. The awards are listed as following:

7. Awards for Taiwan Cycling League will be presented at the end of the year.

## Please Notice:

1. The participant voluntarily and independently decides to participate in the cycling races organized by the Taiwan Cyclist Federation.
2. Other events, such as the "Tour of East Taiwan 365 & 160 Challenge," will be held on the same weekend. Relatives and friends are welcome to participate.
3. Participants must review the guidelines and instructions provided by the organizer for this event, understand the relevant reminders, competition rules, and precautions, and have no objections.
4. The Hualien and Taitung Police Department has issued a special statement: If team vehicles engage in improper overtaking or driving against traffic during the event, strict enforcement and fines will be imposed. This is to ensure everyone's safety and the continuation of the event. Team leaders are requested to inform their teams to comply with traffic regulations and avoid endangering themselves or others.
5. In addition to the event's public liability insurance, all participants are required to arrange their own personal accident insurance.
6. Participants should consider their personal abilities and health conditions when taking part in the cycling challenge. If feeling unwell, please rest at a safe location by the roadside and avoid exceeding personal physical limits.
7. After the event, each team's team car is required to shuttle participants to their accommodation.
8. Please carefully review the event guidelines. If you have any concerns or cannot agree to all the terms and conditions, please do not register for the event.
9. Participants are only required to use standard drop-bar road bicycles. Bicycles must be equipped with a fully functional braking system. Electric-assisted bicycles are not allowed. Bicycle-specific helmets must be worn at all times.
10. Water bottles must be bicycle-specific. To prevent bottles from falling during the ride and endangering other riders, participants should inspect and adjust their bottle cages to ensure they are securely fastened.

11. Participants must thoroughly inspect their bicycles before the event, including component assembly and tire pressure, to ensure the bike is in optimal condition for safety.
12. This competition will not provide traffic control to exclude other road users except for the leading group and the main peloton. Participants who are behind the main group but have not been eliminated from the competition must adhere to traffic rules, traveling in the right direction and staying to the right to ensure safety.
13. Participants must always carry their National Health Insurance card or identification documents. In case of injury, please seek medical attention on the day of the event and obtain medical proof and receipt to facilitate insurance claims.
14. The cycling event has a certain level of difficulty. Participants should monitor their health condition and carefully consider the risks involved. Those with hypertension, cardiovascular diseases, heart conditions, diabetes, epilepsy, asthma, or other conditions unsuitable for strenuous exercise are not permitted to participate in this challenge or event. (Participants should assess whether they have any of the conditions above. If they choose to participate despite having such conditions, the organizer will not be held liable for any resulting accidents or injuries.)
15. Participants may experience falls, collisions, or other accidents during the challenge or event. The organizer is not responsible for any compensation beyond insurance coverage for such incidents.
16. It is inevitable for participants to have accidents such as falls or collisions during the challenge, and the organizer will not be liable for any compensation other than insurance coverage for such accidents.
16. This event is insured with an NT\$5 million "Public Accident Liability Insurance" by regulations from the Ministry of the Interior. The "Public Accident Liability Insurance" only covers accidental injuries from the organizer's responsibilities. Participants with pre-existing medical conditions should carefully assess their safety and avoid participation. If concerned about the coverage scope of the insurance, participants are advised to purchase additional personal insurance. For details on the coverage, please refer to the "Attachment." The maximum compensation for this event's insurance is covered by the policy, and the organizer will not provide compensation exceeding the policy's payout. If participants do not agree with the

insurance coverage, items, or compensation amounts, they should independently arrange personal accident insurance. It is recommended that participants purchase their cycling race insurance.

17. Team Car Guidelines: During the event and on the route, team cars must follow the instructions of the referees. If a traffic accident involving other people or vehicles (participants, other support vehicles, or other road users) occurs during the event, the incident will be handled according to general traffic accident procedures, and the event organizers will not be held responsible for such accidents. Team car identification stickers will be distributed at the team leader meeting on 4/11, and team car order will be updated at the team leader meeting after the race on 4/12.

18. After participants cross the finish line, they will receive their finisher medals. The following day, after the race, participants must return their timing chips at Sunrise Boulevard to get their deposit refunded.

19. Participants have committed that the personal information they provide is accurate. If the information is incorrect, the individual will bear all consequences.

20. With typhoons or other natural disasters or unforeseen circumstances, the organizers reserve the right to cancel, postpone, or alter the route and methods of the event for safety reasons. Participants must agree to the organizers' decision based on the situation that is most favorable to them.

21. The organizers have the right to publish and display images, results, and media coverage of this event worldwide, including on websites and in publications. By registering, participants agree that their likeness, results, and media or online coverage may be used for event-related promotion and broadcasting.

22. Participants are encouraged to respect nature and refrain from littering.

23. The organizers have the right to accept or reject participant registrations and entries based on factors such as health, age, competition experience, honor records, etc.

24. Any matters not covered in these regulations or any changes may be modified at any time by the organizer.

25. 2025 Taiwan Cyclist League includes Yangmingshan King on 3/22, The Road to Taiwan KOM-Spring on 3/31, Tour of East Taiwan from 4/11 to 4/13, Taipingshan King of Mountain on 5/3, The Road to Taiwan KOM-Summer on 6/30, Hualien Pacific Road Race on 11/15, and Yunlin Cycling Criterium on 12/6.

26. The latest information about this event will be announced any time on the "[Taiwan Cyclist Federation](#)" Facebook page. Please follow the latest information carefully.

### Remarks:

1. Any issues related to the competition should be formally submitted in writing to the event's judging committee by the team leader or coach within 30 minutes after the race. A deposit of NT\$3,000 must be submitted along with the appeal. The final decision will be made by the judging committee. If the appeal is unsuccessful, the deposit will be forfeited.

2. If an appeal is not submitted following the above procedure and interferes with the race, the judging team will take appropriate action to maintain the integrity of the event.








### Route Map - 4/11
