



2026 King of Taipingshan Road Race and Team Time Trial

The Taipingshan National Forest Recreation Area has been famous for its diversified forest resource as well as its ample creature ecology. This cycling event, starting from Changbeihu and ending at Jancing Historic Trail, is a 45-km national-level scenic route with averaged 7% ascending winding to the finish at 1,972-meter altitude. Beautiful yet challenging, come to ride for the King of Taipingshan!

Event Information

Date: May 9th, 2026 (Saturday)

Departure Location: Changbeihu Scenic Area, Yilan.

Route: Changbeihu/Start (Altitude 190m) → Route 7C → Taiya 1 Road / Niudou → Duowang Bridge → Jioujihze → Jhongjian Visitor Center → Bailing → Jancing Historic Trail Entrance/Finish (Altitude 1,952m). Total Distance: 45kms.

Route description: averaged 7% winding ascending before Bailing, and 12~14% slopes after that. It could be foggy in that season.

Feeding Station:

1. Duowang Bridge / 22.7km
2. Jhongjian Visitor Center / 29.2km
3. Bailing Pavilion / 35.8km

Team Time Trial Route: Chingshei Bridge to Niudou Bridge, Total Distance: 12kms.

Team Time Trial:

Participants must be older than 16 years old, and register as a group. The team time trial is limited to participants who have signed up for the road race. Each team should include 5 members, and the team's score is based on the time of the 4th person reaching the finish line. A team jersey for each team is required. There are no gender limitations.

Challenge Category:

No limitation of age nor bike. Legal pedelec (electric-assisted) bicycles are valid.

Entry fee: : NT\$1,000 for Age Category

NT\$600 for Junior High School Category

(plus another NT\$500/per person time chip deposit fee to be prepaid.)

Entry fee includes: Scenic Area Ticket, Souvenir, Number plates, Electronic Finisher Certificate, Feeding service, Basic insurance.

● The registration is open until April 26th, 2026.

Event Schedule:

06:00 Riders gathering / Check-in @ Changbeihu Scenic Area Parking Lot.

06:00 TTT Race start / according to the order announced.

07:00 Opening ceremony.

08:00 Road Race start.

09:30 ETA of first road race rider arriving at finish line.

10:00 Award giving / Food supply / Chip return @ Jancing Parking Lot.

11:00 Downhill transportation Jancing to Tuchang, on batches of 20-min intervals.

12:00 Finish area closed.

●Event Transportations:

1. Full transportation: Xindian – Yilan Changbeihu and Jancing – Xindian bus: 05:30 Xindian (MRT Xindian District Office Exit 2) departure. NT\$1,000 per person with bike. Bikes must be properly packaged.
2. Downhill transportation: 11:00 Jancing departure to Changbeihu. NT\$600 per person with bike.

Awards:

- a. The NT Dollar prize awards are as below:

- b. Riders may download electronic certificate and score ranking data from the Organizer's website.
- c. Top 6 placed Overall/Women riders will be awarded trophies and prize money.
- d. TTT top 6 placed teams will be awarded trophies.
- e. The annual race series trophies will be given at the end of the series.

The event day traffic control:

- a. The ascending traffic control process on event route will be held on the event day (07:30~12:00, Jiayuan Bridge to Taipingshan Villa Parking Lot). No motorized vehicles will be allowed to go uphill during the process.
- b. Team cars would like to go uphill must leave no later than 07:30. Entrance ticket Adult NT\$200/Half fare NT\$100. Car ticket NT\$100. Team cars please park at Jancing Parking Lot or the Taipingshan Villa Parking lot.)

Notice:

1. Riders are only permitted to ride bikes with full braking system. The bicycle must be mounted with front and rear lighting for illumination when going through tunnels.
2. Riders registering the event means he/she fully acknowledge the event information and agree with them.
3. Please make sure that your bike is properly maintained prior to the event and remember to bring your personal spare parts.
4. Riders' event identification materials must be properly attached during the event.
5. Riders must ride on the right side of road and obey traffic rules. Riding in the wrong direction/lane (left side) is prohibited.
6. The rider insurance of this event is Public Liability Insurance, in which any personal health problem during the event or any riding injury caused by personal health problem

will not be included in this insurance. Riders are recommended to buy personal health and medical care insurance.

7. Participants will be covered with the Travel Insurance and the Public Liability Insurance. The Public Liability Insurance covers the accident only that Organizer is responsible for. Each participant should evaluate his/her own safety regarding personal health conditions when deciding whether to participate in his event. Participants should apply for extra personal insurance policy at his/her own cost when considering that the aforementioned insurance is insufficient. Please refer to the Insurance Policy Website for the coverage details of the [Travel Insurance](#) and the [Public Liability Insurance](#). The Organizer is only responsible for the indemnity amount with the maximum payment of claims per person as the insurance policy offers. Do not register the event if you do not agree with the coverage, items, indemnity amount of insurance policy.
8. According to the Insurance Law, riders under 15 years old would not be compensated with death indemnity under Life or Injury Insurance policy.
9. For the medical insurance needs, if any hospital medical treatment is caused by an event accident, keep all receipt and diagnosis certificates (issued by a doctor) and give these later to the Taiwan Cyclist Federation for insurance payment application needs.
10. This event is a physically challenging ride. Riders who have hypertension, cardiopathy, asthma, cardiovascular diseases, diabetes, epileptoid, are not recommended to join this event.
11. The Organizer has the right to stop riders from riding depending on the rider's health condition at any time before or during the event.
12. Riders with time chips installed must pass the time recording zone at the Start Point and at the Finish Point for official time recordings.
13. Depending on the weather or any natural disaster, the Organizer has the right to stop or cancel the event, with regards to concern for rider safety.
14. Riders shall not dispose of any rubbish throughout the route and event area.
15. The Organizer has the right to use any reports/articles and images of the event for promotional purposes.
