

# 2012 Duathlon at Jiaosi, Yilan

## 第二屆礁溪龍潭湖鐵人二項賽

The 2012 Duathlon at Jiaosi will be held in one of the most famous nature reserved area in Yilan County. The course runs by a lake and is surrounded by mountains. When running and cycling through the Longtan Lake scenic area, competitors' attention will most probably drawn by the incredibly calm and photogenic environment.

### Duathlon Race:

#### 2012.02.25 (Sat.) Athletes Registration

**Event Location :** Longtan Lake parking lot area

### Courses :

1. Junior Duathlon : Run 1.8km → Ride 6km → Run 1.8km , Total 9.6km
2. Duathlon : Run 6km → Ride 12km , Total 18km

### Bicycle :

- For safety reasons, diameter of bicycle tires must be 26-inch or larger. Folding bikes or smaller wheels and tires are NOT allowed.)
- 24-inch wheel bicycles can be used by Junior Duathlon racers.

### Participants :

1. Junior Duathlon : Students in 4-,5-,6-grade (Elementary School) or in Junior High School.
2. Duathlon : Male or Female age 16 or older

### Fees :

NT\$700 per person (Duathlon / Junior Duathlon); Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.

**Services :**

Insurance, meal, certificate & medal(for finisher), organizing bag, premium, lucky draw.

**Deposit for Time Chip :**

NT\$1,000 (per chip / per person), NOT to be reclaimed if chip lost during race.

**Race Entry :**

- Last date of Registration - 2012.01.31 (Registrations are NOT subject to modification after this date.)

**Payment :**

Participants will be given particular bank account information for wiring fees after finishing online registration.

**Duathlon Age Groups :**

1. M16 / Male Age 16-19 ( 1993-1996 )
2. M20 / Male Age 20-24 ( 1988-1992 )
3. M25 / Male Age 25-29 ( 1983-1987 )
4. M30 / Male Age 30-34 ( 1978-1982 )
5. M35 / Male Age 35-39 ( 1973-1977 )
6. M40 / Male Age 40-44 ( 1968-1972 )
7. M45 / Male Age 45-49 ( 1963-1967 )
8. M50 / Male Age 50-54 ( 1958-1962 )
9. M55 / Male Age 55 and older ( - 1957 )
10. W20 / Female Age 34 (and/or younger) ( 1978 - )
11. W30 / Female Age 35(and/or older) ( - 1977 )

### Junior Duathlon Groups :

1. Junior High Male (Student ID required)
2. Junior High Female (Student ID required)
3. Elementary School Male (Student ID required)
4. Elementary School Female (Student ID required)

### Prizes :

#### Duathlon :

1. Top 6 of each age group will be awarded with trophies. (Top 6 winners overall will not be ranked in his/her respective age group.)
2. Top 6 overall will be awarded with trophies and cash prizes, but will not be ranked within the respective age group. Cash prizes for 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> places are listed as follows : NT\$3,000 · NT\$2,500 · NT\$2,000 · NT\$1,500 · NT\$1,000 · and NT\$1,000 for each place respectively.
3. Teams winning 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> places will be awarded trophies and cash prizes. Cash prizes: NT\$10,000 · NT\$6,000 · NT\$5,000 · NT\$4,000 · NT\$3,000 · NT\$2,000 for each place respectively.
4. When there are less than 10 races in a particular age group, the winners of that group will only be given half of the winner's points.
5. Calculation for teams :

### Junior Groups :

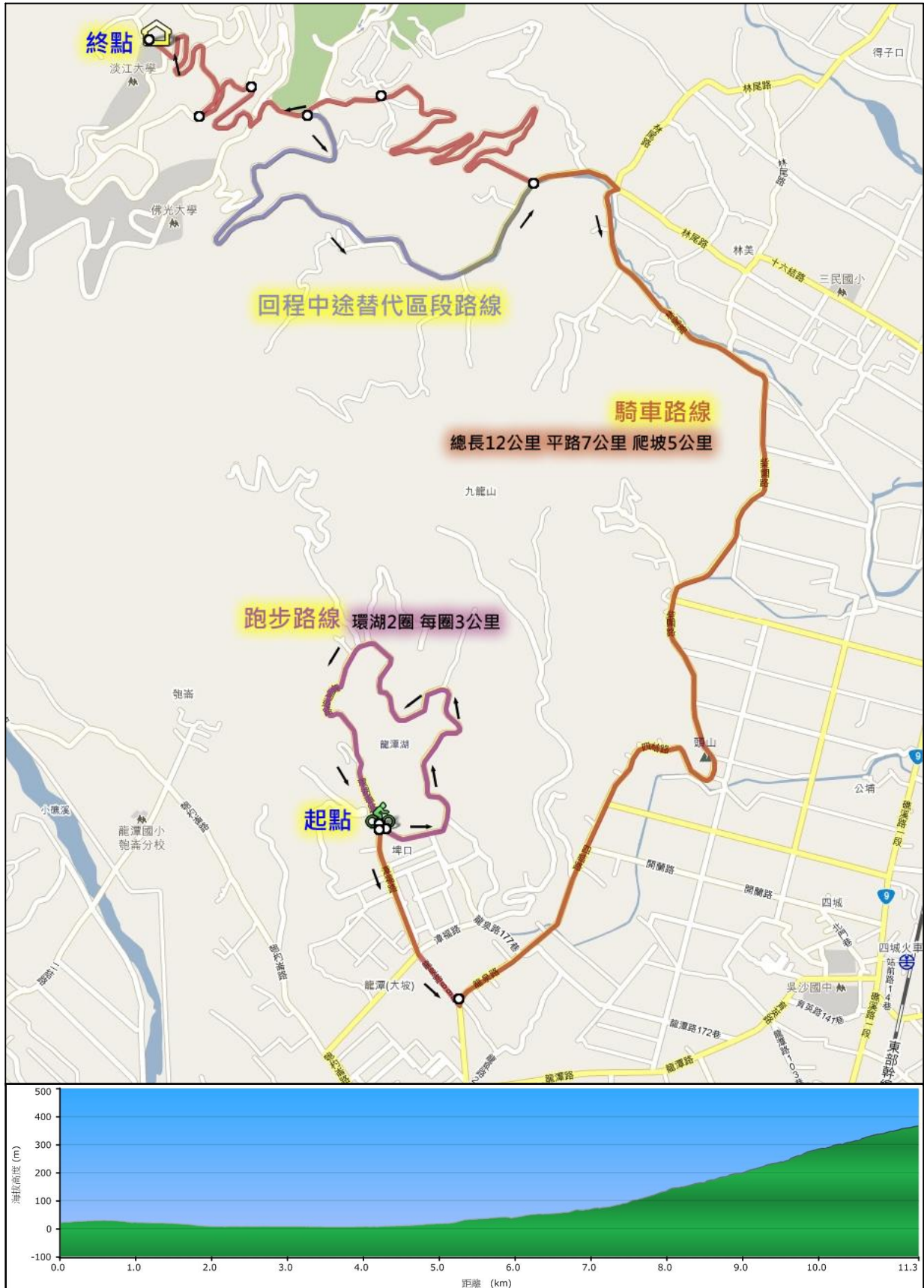
1. Top 6 of each group will be awarded with trophies.
2. Racers finish the race within time limit will be awarded with medals and certificates.
3. Teams of Junior Groups will be awarded with winner's points but no cash prize will be offered.

### Rules and Regulations :

1. The Duathlon race applies ITU triathlon rules and regulations. The organizer may revise  
or  
mandate addition rules to ensure safety of the race.
2. Any objection to the race result should be filed to the Commissaire Committee in written form within  
20 minutes after race. No further objection shall be allowed after receiving the decision made by the Commissaire Committee.

## Courses & Routes :

1. Junior Duathlon : Run 1.8km (600m x 3 laps) → Ride 6km (3km x 2 laps)  
→ Run 1.8km (600m x 3 laps) , Total 9.6km
2. Duathlon : Run 6km (3km x 2 laps) → Ride 12km (1 lap) , Total 18km



### **Time Chip :**

1. The race applies a professional time chip system to keep tracking results of racers.  
Racers mis-place or lose the Time Chip will be disqualified.
2. Time Chip sensor zone will be set up at the Start Point.  
Racers must go through the Start zone to activate the Time Chip in order to receive accurate time record.
3. Deposit of the Time Chip is NT\$1,000 per chip (per person).  
Racers must return the Time Chip after race to reclaim deposit.

### **Remarks :**

1. Time limit for the race is 2 hours 30 minutes.
2. Bicycles used for the race must have brakes installed for both wheels. While type of bikes is not strictly regulated, folding bikes and bikes with wheels smaller than 26 inches are NOT allowed. (Junior racers may use 24-inch wheel bikes.)
3. Winners should be present at the award ceremony. Awards will NOT be presented after the event.
4. Racers should be prepared for un-pleasant weather conditions.  
Warm clothes and rain gear should be prepared by the racers.
5. Racers should have their own government issued health insurance card prepared in case of emergency. Hospital documents and receipts should be kept for insurance claim after treatment.
6. Racers are responsible for their personal health conditions.  
Anyone who has cordial or other serious health conditions should NOT participate into the race.
7. The race organizer shall provide appropriate insurance for the event.  
However, insurance coverage will be limited.  
Racer may choose to upgrade his/her own policy through his/her insurance company agent.  
Racers who have acknowledged serious personal health conditions that choose to race are rather taking their own risk.
8. Racers should finish their TCF membership registration and complete the race admission form prior  
to the race in order to receive proper insurance coverage.  
No on-site admission to the race will be allowed.
9. To protect the environment, please use your personal reusable utensils and do not litter.
10. In case of natural disasters or unavoidable conditions affecting the race,  
racers should support the organizer's decision upon the race.
11. Should a racer appear to be not suitable to race, the organizer shall cease his/her participation in  
the course.
12. In case of serious weather or natural conditions unfavorable to the race,  
the organizer shall postpone or cancel the race, depending upon the circumstances.
